With onsite nursing 16 hours a day and on-call 24 hours a day, Hope Residence provides an extensive array of services to support and enhance the lives of its residents.

The community hosts a sensory room, onsite occupational, physical and speech therapies. Residents can also participate in social and recreational services onsite and in the community.

CARE OF THE SOUL

Care of the soul is a key part of life at Hope Residence.

An ordained WELS chaplain is part of our team, providing residents spiritual care through:

- Simplified “Worship at the Cross” services
- Bible studies
- Devotions
- Personal visits

Transportation is also available to attend community church services.

Our CAREGIVERS

Hope Residence team members work with families, guardians and case managers to provide person-centered care. Team members provides the highest degree of quality care to each resident as prescribed by the physicians and the individual program plan.

- Nursing team members onsite 16 hours per day, on-call 24/7/365.
- Administer medications, insulin, etc.
- Implement resident goals.
- Assist resident with daily activities.
- Coordinate and maintain resident schedule.
- Care for individuals with diabetes, epilepsy, mental illness, physiological needs and dementia.
- Follow resident positive support plans.
- Coordinate resident participation in community, vocation, church and campus activities.

Hope Residence offers comprehensive, personal care for adults with intellectual, physical, developmental disabilities and/or related conditions.

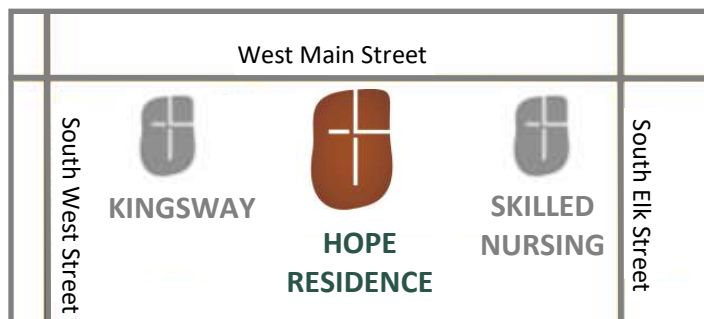
We provide an extensive array of services to support and enhance the lives of residents with disabilities such as Down syndrome, cerebral palsy and autism.
